RICARDO MILLER ADDS EXPLOSIVE THREAT TO HURRICANES OFFENSE

Michigan WR Ricardo Miller has signed to complete the 2017 season as a Hurricane in the GFL.

Head Coach Felix Motzki and the Saarland Hurricanes were able to agree on terms with explosive WR standout from Michigan, Ricardo Miller.

Ricardo Miller fits the bill for the Saarland Hurricanes offense, which was in search for a physical wide receiver that could blow the top off of coverages and create mismatches underneath by aligning up at different spots in the formation.

“We went after Ricardo pretty hard because he is exactly what we needed in terms of a guy that can beat one on one coverage, adds a deep threat with speed and could bully smaller defensive backs on the goal line and off the edge.” – Tyler Reese, Offensive Coordinator

Ricardo played high school football in Florida and Michigan and was the nation's 27 best receiver and a four-star prospect his senior year.

After committing to Michigan early, Ricardo went on to play through his junior season as a wolverine. Ricardo won his first letter as a sophomore, where he played as an H-Back and Special Teams Returner in 8 games to win the Sugar Bowl. After appearing in 5 games a junior and receiving Academic All Big-10 honors at the same position Ricardo transferred to the University of Massachusetts where he completed his college career in 2013 to see more time at wide receiver.

After not being taken in the 2014 NFL Draft Ricardo continued trying to land a spot with a team in the NFL as free agent and also in the CFL. To this point in Ricardo's career he has only made one stop into the European leagues and that was in the 2016 season in Sweden with the Uppsala 86ers where he was a standout. Ricardo is looking forward to the possibility of facing either of his former 86ers teammates Jared Stegman of Kiel Baltic Hurricanes or Jacob Adelman of the Hildesheim Invaders.
